**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB3815 prohibits candidates, political action committees, and ballot measure committees from knowingly accepting foreign principal contributions. Violations lead to returning or forfeiting funds to the Ethics Commission, with harsher penalties for repeat offenses. It also defines and limits foreign principals from financially supporting state or local candidates, political action committees, ballot measures, and related political ads.
