**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3843 authorizes a student who has completed 1,000 hours of cosmetology or barber training to work as a student apprentice in a salon or barber shop under the supervision of a licensed professional with at least five years of experience. Apprentices must be paid fairly, and the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering must outline details of such compensation.
