**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 3856 adds upland winged game to the type of game you can hunt in a commercial area with a 10 day small game hunting license. A 10 day hunting license for residents hunting small game and upland winged game is required to hunt upland game in commercial hunting areas. The provisions of this measure exclude wild turkey.
