Research Analysis

The floor substitute to HB 3856 allows the Director of Wildlife Conservation to provide residents and nonresidents with a five-day paper hunting license for upland winged game, excluding wild turkeys, to hunt in a commercial hunt area. The license fee for both residents and nonresidents is \$5.

CHANGES IN FLOOR SUB VERSION FROM COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE:

The floor substitute changes the license from a ten-day license to a five-day paper license.

Fiscal Analysis

The floor amendment provides clean-up language as in the committee substitute version around day limited upland winged game licenses. As the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation is a non-appropriated agency, there is still no fiscal impact for the state on this measure.

This measure helps provide some clean-up language on a licensing change that took affect last year and should not create a fiscal impact for the state or for the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation.
