Research Analysis

HB 3860, as introduced, creates the School Safety Interoperability Fund to be used for acquiring and maintaining school safety interoperability programs and administered by the Department of Public Safety. The funds may be distributed to any county, municipality, school district, or law enforcement department that establishes a school safety interoperability program that encompasses public, charter, and private schools, provides encrypted communication systems, integrates with school panic alarm systems, and complies with certain federal regulations.

The measure establishes a school safety revolving fund that is to be administered by the Department of Public Safety. Monies to the fund would be appropriated by the Legislature for the purposes of providing grants to certain political subdivisions within the state.
