Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 3889 requires the District Attorneys Council to develop and implement a five-year Domestic Violence Forensic Exam Pilot Program, subject to the availability of funds. The pilot program is to provide counties having a population greater than 100,000 with qualified licensed health care professionals to conduct domestic violence forensic exams for victims of domestic violence assault.
