# **Fiscal Analysis**

As introduced, HB3912 creates a sales tax exemption for hearing aid devices.

Analysis from the Oklahoma Tax Commission:

### REVENUE IMPACT:

Based on OTC sales tax reporting and remittance data, \$946,000 in state sales tax is attributable to the sales of hearing aids for FY 23. Assuming similar taxable sales of hearing aids for FY 24 and FY 25, and accounting for inflation<sup>1</sup>, an estimated \$986,000 decrease in sales tax collection in FY 25 is expected.

## FY 25: \$986,000 decrease in state sales tax collections
