Research Analysis

HB 3930 requires state governmental entities to install an ADA compliant bidet facility in at least one of their publicly assessable restrooms by January 1, 2026. The provisions of this measure also applies to the restrooms within the Oklahoma State Capitol and in buildings controlled by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3930 would require all state government entities to install at least one facility with a publicly accessible restroom with a bidet that meets the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) has provided the following cost breakdown of a bidet installation for various scenarios that may arise with the implementation of this measure:

Restroom Type	Cost Range
Current ADA compliant accessible restroom	\$20,000 - \$30,000
Current ADA compliant accessible restroom that would no	\$50,000 - \$60,000
longer be compliant without additional renovation	
Non-ADA complaint accessible restroom (may include	\$50,000 - \$160,000
buildings constructed or renovated pre-1990)	

OMES does state that if this measure would allow for the option of an integrated toilet and bidet unit, the cost range for installation would potentially decrease to Six to Ten Thousand dollars (\$6,000 - \$10,000) per installation if only minimal renovation is required.
