Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3937 removes expired provisions from the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act that allowed public bodies to meet by teleconference during the threat of Covid-19. The measure clarifies that public bodies are to post meeting information at the principal office of the public body or at the location of the meeting and on their website, including information regarding special meetings.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3937 requires all public bodies to post information regarding regularly scheduled meetings in prominent public view at the principal office of the public body or at the location of the meeting as well as on the public body's internet website.
