HB 3938 provides that for Class D driver licenses, a self-certification that the applicant is medically able to drive safely is to be considered sufficient to assure Service Oklahoma that the person is not prohibited from being licensed.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3938 would permit a self-certification by an applicant for a Class D driver license that they are medically able to drive safely. Service Oklahoma estimates an implementation cost of Twenty-four Thousand, Two Hundred and Eighty-eight dollars (\$24,288.00) in order to make the requisite systematic changes to the current credentialing system.
