**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 3943 requires the 10 highest-funded state agencies to submit quarterly expenditure reports to the legislature within 30 days of the end of each quarter. The reports must include the date, amount, description, and source of each expenditure or disbursement. Each report must also be posted on the agencies' websites.
