**Research Analysis**

The committee amendment to HB 3943 modifies the reporting requirement to apply to the 10 highest funded state agencies rather than only the State Department of Education.

HB 3943, as amended, requires the 10 highest funded state agencies to submit quarterly expenditure reports to the legislature within 30 days of the end of each quarter. The reports must include the date, amount, description, and source of each expenditure or disbursement. Each report must also be posted on the agencies' websites.
