Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3977 provides that it is unlawful for any person applying for employment with an employer other than the State of Oklahoma to knowingly make a materially false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or representation on an employment application. Upon conviction, the person is subject to a fine of up to \$1,000 and will have his or her name included on a registry maintained by the Office of the Attorney General.
