Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB3897 establishing a new matrix for determining the sales tax relief credit and increases the credit amount from \$40 to up to \$200 per person, depending on the filing category and gross household income of the taxpayer. For single filers, the full \$200 credit may be claimed by those making less than \$30,000 and phases out for those making \$40,000 or more. For seniors, disabled persons and families with dependents, the full \$200 per person credit may be claimed by households with a gross household income less than \$45,000 and phases out for those making \$60,000 or more.
