Fiscal Analysis

HB 3989 directs the Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH) to establish standards and criteria for administration of the Lung Cancer Screening Program.

OSDH estimates this measure requiring 1.5 full-time equivalents (FTE) to implement and having a total fiscal impact on the agency of four hundred fifty-six thousand two hundred ninety-one dollars (\$456,291.00). The passing of this measure would require OSDH to request additional appropriations in the full amount to cover costs.
