## **Fiscal Analysis**

This measure helps expands the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation's (ODWC) Hunters Against Hunger program by allowing the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (ODAFF) to create a special license that would allow already regulated meat processors to process deer meat during deer season. ODAFF does not believe the change would create a fiscal impact for the agency. ODWC is a non-appropriated agency, already pays non-regulated deer processors for meat donated through the program, and believes it can expand the program currently. As ODAFF does not believe there will be a fiscal impact, and ODWC is a non-appropriated agency, there should be no fiscal impact to the state budget.
