Research Analysis

HB4066, as introduced, creates the Federal Overreach and Extraordinary Litigation Revolving Fund for the Office of the Attorney General. The AG can use these fund to monitor actions of the federal government that are in violation of the 10th Amendment, administer the State Reserve Powers Protection Unit or for litigation expenses related to foreign threats, interstate crime, terrorist organizations, gross violations of public trust and statewide public safety.
