## **Research Analysis**

HB 4073, as introduced, requires public school districts to implement school security alert and response systems from a State Board of Education-approved list. Every system should be capable of the following:

- Automatically alerting school personnel when an emergency response is initiated on-site by a phone application, phone call, text message, or other technology;
- Providing emergency responders with floor plans and caller location; and
- Integrating school personnel with emergency responders to provide updates during an emergency.
