**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure increases both the resident and non-resident stamps and licenses for water fowl. The Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation (ODWC), believes that the increase revenue for the next two years at about \$400,000.00 As ODWC is a non-appropriated agency, that revenue will be used by ODWC for its operations, thus it will not create a fiscal impact for the state.

This amendment changes the effective date of the bill, and does not change the fiscal impact of the measure.
