Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 4086 increases the fee for a waterfowl hunting stamp and license from \$9 to \$20 for residents 18 years and older and to \$30 for nonresidents 18 years and older. Additionally, the measure increases the age of residents that are exempt from the requirement of having a waterfowl hunting stamp or license to legally hunt waterfowl from 16 to 18 years of age.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure increases both the resident and non-resident stamps and licenses for water fowl. The Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation (ODWC), believes that the increase revenue for the next two years at about \$400,000.00 As ODWC is a non-appropriated agency, that revenue will be used by ODWC for it's operations, thus it will not create a fiscal impact for the state.
