**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 4091 allows a county fire protection or emergency services entity to request reimbursement for providing services outside of their jurisdiction if there is no existing agreement between the county and the jurisdiction where they provided services. The Office of the State Fire Marshal is authorized to mediate reimbursement disputes. The measure provides for the State Fire Marshal to consider response time, financial burden, and service capabilities when mediating disputes.
