Research Analysis

HB 4093 requires a retail electric service supplier to provide notice to the incumbent supplier and the public utility district that the non-incumbent supplier intends to provide service to a new electric-consuming facility. The notice must be submitted at least 15 days before a contract is made between the non-incumbent service provider and the new facility and must include the geographic coordinates of the consuming facility, the size of the connected load, and the tariff under which the supplier intends to serve the facility.
