Research Analysis

HB4127, as introduced, authorizes up to three days of paid administrative leave to full and part-time county employees to serve as precinct officials, absentee voting board members, or other authorized election workers if they meet the legal qualifications and receive approval from their appointing authority. Employees will receive compensation for extra hours worked but will not receive the daily payment for precinct officials or absentee voting board members.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 4127 allows county employees to be granted up to three (3) days of paid administrative leaves to serve as an election worker. As this measure is only applicable to county-level employees, there is no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
