**Research Analysis**

The floor substitute to HB 4133 creates the Oklahoma Affordable Housing Commission and revolving fund. The Commission is to be made up of 16 members and its purpose is to address the needs of extremely low income, very low income, low income, moderate income, and middle income households to promote suitable housing conditions to as many people as possible.

**CHANGES IN FLOOR SUB VERSION FROM INTRODUCED VERSION:**

The floor substitute removes the language requiring the Governor to give notice when traveling out of state and adds language creating the Oklahoma Affordable Housing Commission and revolving fund.
