Fiscal Analysis

Of the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Human Services (OKDHS) in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125, specific appropriations are for:

- \$3,000,000.00 for Home- and Community-Based Services Waivers;
- Adequate amount for 25% increase to certain provider rates;
- Adequate amount for 12.5% increase to certain provider rates;
- Adequate amount for 10% increase to certain services and their related respite;
- \$5,600,000.00 to the credit of the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Account;
- All federal monies received by the state to fund Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Block Grant and the Child Care and Development Block Grant; and
- Maintain funding for senior nutrition programs from the prior fiscal year.
