**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to SB 1184 appropriates \$12.5 million to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department. Appropriated funds must be used on state park properties in accordance with the plan submitted to the Senate and House of Representatives Appropriation and Budget chairs.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1184 appropriates Twelve Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$12,500,000) from the Oklahoma Capital Assets Maintenance and Protection Fund to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department to expend on properties within the state park system. Thus, this measure creates a \$12,500,000 impact for the state.
