Research Analysis

SB1189 appropriates from the Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury \$18,460,000.00 to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services or so much thereof as may be necessary due to increased costs of the project funded in Section 2 of HB1013 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature. The measure creates a Special Account for the appropriated monies. The Department is authorized to request in writing that the funds be deposited or transferred into the account created by the act. The Department may enter into memorandums of understanding and may promulgate rules and establish procedures as well as use existing rules and procedures in order to implement the provisions of the act. The Department must retain no more than 2% of the funds for eligible reimbursements. The Department must submit a quarterly report on the budgeting, management, and expenditure of funds as well as copies of memorandums of understanding and third party contracts. No more than six months after the effective date, they must also provide a status update on the implementation of the act's provisions to the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding, at their request.
