Research Analysis

SB1190 appropriates from the Statewide Recovery Fund to the Military Department of Oklahoma the following allotments:

- \$2,215,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary due to increased costs of the project funded in Section 1 of SB15 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature;
- \$1,190,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary due to increased costs of the project funded in Section 2 of SB15 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature; and
- \$800,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary due to increased costs of the project funded in Section 3 of SB15 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature.

The measure creates a Statewide Recovery Special Account for the Military Department for each appropriation section in the act. The Department is authorized to request in writing that the monies appropriated be deposited or transferred to the created accounts. The Department may also enter into memorandums of understanding and promulgate rules or establish procedures as well as use existing rules and procedures to implement the provisions of the act.

The Department must retain no more than 2% of the funds for eligible reimbursements. The Department must submit a quarterly report detailing fund budgeting, expenditure, and management as well as a copy of all memorandums of understanding and third party contracts. The Department must appear before the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding, at their request, no later than 6 months after the act's effective date to provide a status update on implementation.
