Research Analysis

Senate Bill 1192 directs the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to transfer \$8,085,454 from the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to the Department of Human Services. This transfer, effective immediately upon the measure's enactment, is intended to provide additional funding for a grant program that supports food programs, ensuring the availability and access to affordable and nutritious foods.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 1192 provides for the transfer of \$8,085,454.00, which was allocated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce in prior bill (SB 6xx) of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, to the Oklahoma Department of Human Services for the grant program that provides assistance to food programs which support the availability of and access to affordable and nutritious foods. The measure merely transfers monies from previously allocated funds. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
