Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 126 updates procedures for when a public school student is arrested for a violent crime. The measure requires an arrest notification, which is sent to the district superintendent upon arrest, to be kept in the student's permanent records. If the student is convicted and transfers schools, such arrest notification must be transferred to the receiving district. Beginning next school year, schools are required to request information regarding potential violent crimes for any student seeking a transfer to their district.
