## Fiscal Analysis

SB 1279 requires the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to establish funding to administer a pilot program in effort to increase the number of Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) trained officers. Officials from DPS anticipate issuing direct grants to agencies to cover overtime costs for officers attending and teaching ARIDE training. In its current form, SB 1279 has no direct fiscal implications for the state.
