**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1310 transfers the administrative duties of state-sponsored health and dental benefit plans from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA). Since the Employees Group Insurance Division of OMES is self-funded, OHCA does not anticipate the provisions of this measure to have a negative impact on the agency's budget, thus having no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
