Research Analysis

SB 1323 allows a retired district attorney, assistant district attorney or district attorney investigator to keep ownership of the sidearm, badge, and holster carried by the district attorney immediately prior to retirement. The district attorney, assistant district attorney or district attorney investigator may purchase the rifle or shotgun issued to the district attorney.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure authorizes certain lawful retention of items after retirement by some district attorney employees. In certain cases, proceeds may be generated and deposited into the District Attorneys Evidence Fund, however the amount of such deposits cannot be predicted. In its current form, SB1323 will generate some revenues for the District Attorneys Evidence Fund but a material impact on state budget or appropriations is not anticipated.
