Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to SB 1323 allows a retired district attorney or assistant district attorney to keep ownership of the sidearm, badge, and holster carried by the district attorney immediately prior to retirement if the district attorney or assistant district attorney has completed a minimum handgun qualification course and is not otherwise disqualified from ownership or possession of a firearm. A retiring district attorney or assistant district attorney may retain his or her status as a law enforcement officer of the State of Oklahoma, retired. A retiring district attorney investigator may also retain status as a law enforcement officer of the State of Oklahoma, retired, and may also be granted custody and ownership of the state-issued sidearm and badge at the discretion of the district attorney.
