**Research Analysis**

The Engrossed version of SB 1442 transfers the authority to issue poultry waste application certificates from the State Board of Agriculture to the Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry. Commercial applicator permits are extended to last five years, and the price is increased from \$15 to \$75.
