Research Analysis

Engrossed SB 1509 allows the money attributed to certain funds to be transferred to and between the agency disbursing funds for current and prior fiscal years. Those funds include the:

- Weight Station Improvement Revolving Fund;
- Oklahoma Railroad Maintenance Revolving Fund;
- Driving on Road Infrastructure with Vehicles of Electricity (DRIVE) Revolving Fund;
- High Priority State Bridge Revolving Fund;
- County Improvements for Roads and Bridges Fund;
- State Highway Construction and Maintenance Fund;
- Rebuilding Oklahoma Access and Driver Safety Fund;
- Public Transit Revolving Fund;
- Rural Economic Transportation Reliability and Optimization Fund; and
- McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System Infrastructure Revolving Fund.

Additionally, the measure modifies the purpose of the Public Transit Revolving Fund to be used for the training or certification of individuals seeking to become registered highway construction materials technicians.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 1509 allows the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) to transfer monies to and between the following revolving funds:

- Weigh Station Revolving Fund
- Oklahoma Railroad Maintenance Revolving Fund
- Driving on Road Infrastructure with Vehicles of Electricity (DRIVE) Revolving Fund
- High Priority State Bridge Revolving Fund
- County Improvements for Roads and Bridges Fund
- State Highway Construction and Maintenance Fund
- Rebuilding Oklahoma Access and Driver Safety (ROADS) Fund
- Rural Economic Transportation Reliability and Optimization (RETRO) Fund
- Public Transit Revolving Fund
- McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System Infrastructure Revolving Fund

As this measure does not appropriate any new funds to any of these revolving funds, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
