Research Analysis

Engrossed Senate Bill 1525 eliminates outdated language regarding the advisory committee's responsibilities to address matters related to service delivery for individuals with developmental disabilities. Additionally, the measure eliminates the requirement to include members from the parent-guardian associations of the Northern Oklahoma Resource Center of Enid and the Southern Oklahoma Resource Center of Pauls Valley.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 1525 cleans up language pertaining to 10 O.S. 2021, § 1412, which relates to advisory committee on service delivery for persons with developmental disabilities. The measure has the sole purpose of removing obsolete language, and does not possess budgetary considerations. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
