**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for SB 1572 requires the Construction Industries Board to register students with proper qualifications as apprentices rather than electrical interns. Student apprentices must also be employed with a licensed electrical contractor and not apply more than 500 hours toward their journeyman requirements.

Student apprentice registration will be issued per school year and expires on the last day of the school year. An apprentice may reregister yearly by meeting the Construction Industries Board's requirements and paying the renewal fee.
