Fiscal Analysis

The Oklahoma Department of Human Services (OKDHS) uses a childcare Restricted Registry to guide the agency in prohibiting certain individuals from licensure, ownership, employment, unsupervised access to children, or residence in a facility or program licensed, certified, operated or contracted by, or with, OKDHS or the Office of Juvenile Affairs (OJA). SB 1641 authorizes appeals of Oklahoma Department of Human Services decisions pertaining to the Restricted Registry to the district court of the county in which the childcare facility is maintained and operated.

After communication with OKDHS, the measure is anticipated to have the following fiscal impact:
