**Research Analysis**

The subcommittee recommendation to Senate Bill 1641 grants any person or anyone on the Restricted Registry affected by a Department of Human Services decision regarding placement on the Restricted Registry the right to appeal to the district court of the county where the childcare facility is located. A successful appeal results in removal from the Registry, with the court empowered to grant suitable relief to the prevailing party. Furthermore, the measure permits aggrieved individuals to pursue legal action against the Department for violations of state laws concerning the procedures for listing individuals on the Restricted Registry.
