Research Analysis

SB 1660 authorizes the issuance of a search warrant to search for a person for whom an arrest warrant has been issued. The measure provides that a search warrant may be issued to allow peace officers to enter, search for, and seize a person for whom an arrest warrant has been issued. The measure provides that a peace officer who executes a search warrant to search a third-party residence for a person with an outstanding warrant must return the search warrant to the magistrate who authorized the warrant or to a magistrate who presides in the judicial district in which the person was found by filing an arrest and booking affidavit or by filing a separate return identifying the person and the location where the person was found.
