Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 171 lowers the number of credit hours an applicant for the certified public accountant exam must complete to 120 hours from 150 hours with the required amount of accounting concentration course hours also being lowered to 24 hours from 30 hours. The measure also provides that an applicant for initial issuance of a certificate must complete least 150 semester hours of college education or the equivalent thereof. 30 of those hours must be in accounting courses above introductory accounting.
