Research Analysis

The PCS1 to SB 1735 provides that it is a misdemeanor crime for any person, with the intent to commit a crime, to enter an area of a commercial business that is commonly reserved for personnel of the business where money or other property is kept, or which is clearly marked that indicates to the public that entry is forbidden. Punishment is up to 1 year in the county jail, a fine of up to \$500 or both fine and imprisonment. A second or subsequent conviction is a felony punishable by up to 2 years in prison, a fine of up to \$1,000 or both fine and imprisonment.
