## **Research Analysis**

SB 1766 lowers the age a person may qualify for the permit to operate farm vehicles from 15 to 13 1/2 years of age. The measure also authorizes public school districts, technology center districts overseen by the Oklahoma Department of Career Technology Education, institutions of higher education, and commercial driver training schools to serve as written proctors for various licenses. The measure directs Service Oklahoma to publish a schedule for the subsequent calendar year of courses and trainings to become designated examiners, as well as available slots for such courses and trainings. The courses and trainings are to occur not less than twice per year. The measure also establishes a 4-year driver school and instructor's license and establishes a fee of \$100.00 for such a license.
