Fiscal Analysis

The conference committee substitute to SB 1766 allows a person 13 and 1/2 years of age who qualifies for a farm permit to operate a vehicle (pursuant to farm permit regulations), enroll in driver's education, and take the driving skills exam. The measure also clarifies various education partners that may serve as written proctors for various licenses. This measure also directs Service Oklahoma to publish a schedule of courses and trainings to become designated examiners and creates a 4-year driver school license. Per Service Oklahoma, administrative costs associated with system updates to allow for this functionality is estimated to cost Sixteen Thousand One Hundred Ninety Two dollars (\$16,192.00) to the agency.
