Fiscal Analysis

SB 1766 lowers the age a person may obtain instructions in a driver education program from 15 to 13 and 1/2 years of age as well as authorizes various education partners to serve as written proctors for various licenses. This measure also directs Service Oklahoma to publish a schedule of courses and trainings to become designated examiners and creates a 4-year driver school license with a One Hundred dollar (\$100.00) for the license. Per Service Oklahoma, administrative costs associated with system updates to allow for this functionality is estimated to cost Sixteen Thousand One Hundred Ninety Two dollars (\$16,192.00) to the agency.
