Research Analysis

The floor amendment to engrossed SB 1771 adds an emergency to the measure.

Engrossed SB 1771, as amended, allows burn ban signs to be posted in rights-of-way by county commissioners or the board of directors of a fire protection district. The placement of such signs must be coordinated with ODOT. The entity that places the sign must remove it upon expiration of the burn ban. This measure will go into effect July 1, 2024.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure allows burn ban signs to be posted in rights-of-way. In its current form, SB1771 is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
