Research Analysis

SB 1780 requires the Transportation Commission to notify a previous property owner if the land they sold, whether it was a partial or total take, to the Commission is going to be offered for sale. The notice is to contain an offer to sell the property back to the previous owner at no greater than the original selling price. Notices must be sent by registered mail and posted on the Department of Transportation's website. Previous property owners have 90 days to accept the Commission's offer of sale.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 1780 requires the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) to notify any previous property owners by registered mail if said property is to be sold in its entirety by the department and that any property sale notices shall be posted to the department's website. As written, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
