SB 1874 designates the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control (OBN), the Oklahoma Highway Patrol (OHP), or any agency authorized by a listed agency as eligible to receive illegal, controlled, and dangerous substances, as well as any contaminated property.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

This measure expands the list of agencies which are designated to receive certain materials related to the seizure of controlled dangerous substances. According to officials with the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs (OBNDD), the fiscal impact is unknown and dependent upon the number of agencies that bring controlled dangerous substances to OBNDD for destruction. Future funding may be needed for storage supplies, storage space, transport, and destruction, however OBNDD is currently not able to quantify any potential costs.
