**Research Analysis**

The Engrossed version of SB 1895 requires the statewide system of alternative education programs to include charter schools and virtual charter schools that have been designated by the State Department of Education. Such schools will be subject to a separate performance framework than traditional charters. The measure also allows a school district to implement alternative education programs using full-time virtual or blended instruction.
